5. **Charity Commission Update**

- The Chairman relayed the following points from the Charity Commission which are liked to an email chain dated Sat 19/02/2011 18:06 and sent out by the Secretary:
 - Adjustment to the 'Friends' Aim. In order that the 'Friends' might in the future register as a charity should the requisite funding level (£5k per annum), there has been a need to amend their aim in line with Charity Commission guidance – broader based criteria. The aim has been adjusted and now meets with Charity Commission guidance.

To raise funds to assist with the maintenance of, improvements to, and preservation of the Church building and churchyard of the Church of St John the Baptist, Wateringbury; and by doing so, support and enable the Church (of England) with the advancement and development of its work within the community of the parish of The Church of St John the Baptist, Wateringbury.

- Relationship with the Parochial Church Council (PCC). The 'Friends' await formal confirmation from the PCC on 22 Mar 11 (following their next meeting). However, initial soundings are that the 'Friends' is independent; will raise funds in support of their aim and on request from the PCC and with 'Friends' Committee agreement. The 'Friends' will have access to the PCC architectural 5 yearly report and the PCC accounts on request to confirm the money given to the PCC has been appropriately spent. The 'Friends' PCC Liaison Member will attend to any such request.
- Business Discounts. While business discounts are allowed they should be a private transaction between the business and the customer. The Committee felt that, for the time-being, All To Note

10. Business Associations

- Businesses Letter of Invitation to Support the 'Friends'. The Business Member and Asst briefed on their concept for seeking support from businesses – a letter and form signed by the Chairman noting that supporting businesses would be invited to support for £20 with their details displayed on the website. The Business Team would contact the Web Designer with new names and details direct, cc the PR Team and Secretary. The PR Team were to remain the Web Designers primary point of contact.
- Business Discounts. Businesses would be encouraged to offer discounts but if given they would be on a private basis with clients and discounts would not be advertised on the website.
- <u>Timeline</u>. The Chaiman stated that the Business Team would have his draft letter to businesses this day (05 Mar 11) and the Business Tm Ldr said he would pass the business letter to the Secretary for Committee comment on 06 Mar 11.
